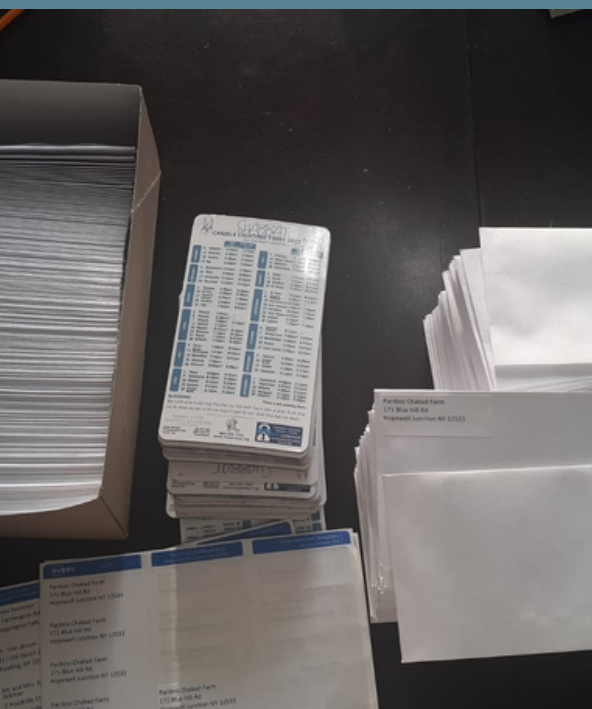
About a year ago a woman we know informed us about her Jewish friend Sarah* who lives in the area but had no connection to anything Jewish. She encouraged Sarah to come on Rosh Hashanah with her children. Although Sarah rsvp'd she didn't actually make it to shul.

Sukkos came. We invited them to the Sukkah party, but they couldn't make it. We dropped off a Challah one Friday. We visited them with the Menorah trailer on Chanukah, but they weren't home so we left doughnuts and a menorah at their door.

Finally, on Purim, Sarah and her family came to the party. They had a fabulous time! This was the family's first Jewish experience. The children had a blast – the 7-year-old daughter even found her classmate at the party! Sarah's husband who is not Jewish was nervous he would feel uncomfortable, but relaxed immediately when he saw how friendly and warm the community is. And Sarah was just thrilled that her family's first Jewish experience was so positive.

We often measure success, based on numbers—it is, after all, the most logical way. But people are not numbers, and success within a community is measured by the impact made on a single individual. So although this Purim we had the largest party since we opened our doors in 2014 (it was indeed epic! See photos below), the attendance of a single Jewish family, is where I found the impact of Purim to be most felt. Who knows how far reaching that will be?

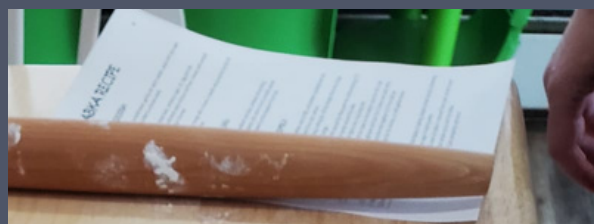
